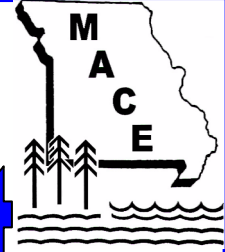

The major topic of discussion this year seemed to be residential sprinklers. The Fire Departments and Districts showed their support for this code change and it was voted to require sprinklers in residential single and multi family structures. There were over 2,200 code changes submitted for adoption and the results can be found on the I.C.C. web site. (iccsafe.org)

I was able to attend some very interesting and informative training classes that were presented by the I.C.C. while at the conference. The one that I found most informative was How to be a Leader not a Manager. I learned a lot of useful information that I can utilize while on the board of M.A.C.E. and in my career as a Code Manager.

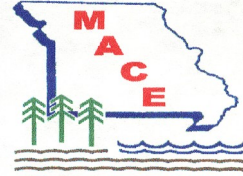

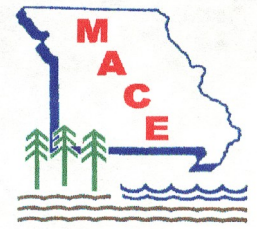
